


EXAMPLE SITE PLAN – UNHEALTHY TREE REMOVAL

Your site plan should include:

- North arrow, property lines, and structures drawn to scale (as best you can)
- Applicant name, street address, and King County parcel identification number
- The distance from at least two property lines for trees to be removed
- Approximate location of all **unhealthy significant trees** to be removed
- Location of any sensitive areas (wetlands, streams, steep slopes) and **replacement trees**. If any trees (non-significant or significant) are being removed within sensitive areas, please mark them.
- A Tree Description Table that lists all **unhealthy significant trees** which are to be removed
