


# EDUCATE

2009



In 2008 Washington Native Plant Society Stewards and community volunteers began converting ½ acre of the Lower Sammamish Commons to a native plant sanctuary. The goal was to educate the public about native plants, native plant upland habitat, and environmentally friendly mulching techniques. Initial weed suppression was accomplished by sheet mulching with a layer of cardboard covered by a thick layer of straw and later supplemented with wood chips.
