ABOUT THE NEW SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCE CHECKLIST

The checklist includes two sections. The first section includes submittal items that are required for all new single-family residence permit applications.

The second section includes submittal items that may be applicable to select single-family residence permit applications.

Please include all the necessary documents to have a complete submittal package, to get you through the review process as quickly as possible.

Please note that demolitions, pools, retaining walls, and detached structures require submittal of a separate demolition or building permit.

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REQUIRED SUBMITTAL ITEMS

The below items are required for <u>all</u> Single-Family Residence Building Permit Applications. A PDF of each document is required at the time of submittal.

	Acceptance of Financial Responsibility - Affidavit of Applicant Status
	 Sewer Availability Certificate Provided by Sammamish Plateau Water or the Northeast Sammamish Water & Sewer District Preliminary Septic Approval by Public Health – Seattle & King County may be provided in lieu of a Sewer Availability Certificate if on septic.
	Proof of Separate, Independent Lot (recently platted lots only) — Please provide a copy of the recorded plat or short plan that shows that the property is recognized as a separate, independent lot.
	Legal Description
	 Must be for parcel(s) related to the building permit application Must be a title-verified description by a Washington State licensed surveyor
	Critical Area Affidavit
	 This affidavit requires applicants to disclose if there are critical areas located on the proposed project site. If you are unsure, please contract with a qualified professional to review on-site and surrounding conditions and determine the presence of critical areas and/or buffers. If critical areas and/or buffers are present, a Critical Areas Study must be submitted as part of the development application. Failure to accurately disclose critical areas information may require additional review, project revisions and/or fees.

	Drainage Review Determination (per Department of Public Works)
	 Mark the applicable project site pathway on the drainage review flowchart on page 45 of the Sammamish Addendum to the 2021 King County Surface Water Design Manual.

☐ SEPA (State Environmental Policy Act) Checklist

- For projects that are not exempt, the City uses the information provided in the SEPA Checklist to help determine whether the environmental impacts of a proposal are significant.
- Checklist information is also used to determine if there are mitigation measures that will address
 the probable significant impacts or if an environmental impact statement will be needed to further
 analyze the proposal.

☐ Critical Area Study

- A Critical Area Report may be required when impacts to an environmentally critical area, or its buffer, may occur and must adequately evaluate the proposal and probable impacts.
- These reports (arborist, geotechnical, critical area, etc.) are sent to City-contracted consultants for peer review at the cost of the applicant.

☐ List of related land use approvals

 This may include Reasonable Use Exceptions, Variances, or Use Permits that have been obtained or are pending before the City or any other governmental entity.

☐ Certificate of Future Sewer Connection

For properties proposed to be served by an on-site sewage (septic) system and/or private well, a
Future Sewer Connection Agreement must be filed with Sammamish Plateau Water or the
Northeast Water & Sewer District.

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
